Dear Property Owner:

The purpose of this mailing is to notify you that the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners, at its regular meeting on August 9, 2022, will be discussing an existing Interlocal Agreement between Alachua County and the City of Alachua relating to the area identified on the map on the back of this page (see “Area Subject to Interlocal Agreement” in red dashed line). You are receiving this notification because you own property within the area that is covered by this existing Interlocal Agreement.

The Interlocal Agreement, which was adopted in 2018 by Alachua County and the City of Alachua, addresses inter-governmental coordination procedures and responsibilities related to road maintenance and any future annexations, and provides for future coordination between the County and City on public services delivery (fire, waste collection, potable water/wastewater) within the specific area shown on the map. The Interlocal Agreement was the result of a governmental conflict resolution process under Chapter 164 of Florida Statutes between Alachua County and the City of Alachua concerning the annexation of the “Rattlesnake Ranch” property along NW 93rd Avenue into the City of Alachua.



The Board of County Commissioners meeting where the Interlocal Agreement will be discussed is scheduled for Tuesday, August 9, 2022 beginning at 11:30 a.m. The meeting will be held at the Jack Durrance Auditorium in the Alachua County Administration Building in downtown Gainesville, FL (12 SE 1st Street, Second Floor). Public are invited to attend the meeting and will have an opportunity to speak. Meeting agendas are typically published on the County’s web site by the Friday prior to the meeting.
