## FIFTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT, #9394, BETWEEN ALACHUA COUNTY AND CORIZON HEALTH, INC. ON MEDICAL CARE CLAIMS FOR ARRESTEES OR DETAINEES

THIS FIFTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT ON MEDICAL CLAIMS FOR ARRESTEES AND DETAINEES (the "Amendment"), made by and between Alachua County, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners (the "County"), and Corizon Health, Inc., a Delaware corporation, ("CORIZON"), is entered into as of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_, 2019. The County and CORIZON shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as the "Parties".

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, CORIZON has entered into an agreement with the Alachua County Sheriff's Office ("Sheriff"), dated October 1, 2017 (the "CORIZON-Sheriff Health Services Agreement") for the provision of health services to persons remanded to the Sheriff's care, custody and control; and

WHEREAS, as part of the CORIZON-Sheriff Health Services Agreement, CORIZON has also agreed to be responsible for the clinical management of individuals (hereinafter referred to as "Arrestees" or "Detainees") who, during the arresting process by any state, county, or municipal law enforcement officer, sustain an injury at the time of a lawful arrest in Alachua County for a state or County violation, or are found to have a pre-existing illness, and are immediately transported by the arresting agency to a designated hospital or medical facility prior to normal processing of such detainee into the Alachua County Jail (the "Jail"); and

WHEREAS, the County may be financially responsible for the costs of health care services rendered to such "Arrestees" or "Detainees" and has entered into its own contract dated October 28, 2014 for Medical Care Claims for Arrestees or Detainees (the "Agreement") with CORIZON for clinical management of "Arrestees" or "Detainees" medical care and to reimburse CORIZON for its costs in accordance with the terms of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, CORIZON and the County have entered into a First Amendment, dated September 25, 2015 (the "First Amendment); entered into the Second Amendment, dated October 25, 2016 (the "Second Amendment); entered into the Third Amendment, dated November 14, 2017 (the "Third Amendment"); and entered into the Fourth Amendment, dated September 11, 2018 (the "Fourth Amendment) to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the CORIZON and the County desire to amend the Agreement again to effectuate the following changes:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises hereinafter made, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Section 6 of the Agreement "Effective Date, Term and Renewal", is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

This Amendment extends the term of the Agreement for an additional one (1) year period through September 30, 2020. CORIZON hereby acknowledges that all terms and conditions of the Agreement fully apply to work (or services) completed prior to the execution of this Amendment

2. This Fifth Amendment shall take effect upon execution by both Parties.

SAVE and EXCEPT as expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the Agreement between the parties, dated October 28, 2014, as amended, shall be and remain in full force and effect.
