

RESOLUTION 20-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO RECOGNIZE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE FOR THE CARES ACT STIMULUS, TO ADMINISTER REVENUES RECEIVED AND AUTHORIZE EXPENDITURES, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to recognize unanticipated revenue for the COVID-19 Relief Fund, to account for and administer Federal stimulus revenues; and,

WHEREAS, the funds shall be used for medical expenses, public health expenses, payroll expenses, compliance with COVID-19 related public health measures, economic support in connection with the COVID-19 public health emergency, and other reasonably necessary expenses related to COVID-19;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. That the fiscal year 2021 budget is amended for the "COVID-19 Relief Fund" and is hereby established as reflected in the budget amendment attached hereto as Exhibit "A". By adoption of this resolution and the attached budget amendment, the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, hereby appropriates and permits the expenditure of the funds described therein.

2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
