The County Attorney seeks authority to file a Petition for Custody of Animal due to Respondent's inability to provide adequate care for at least one dog. On July 24, 2019, an ACAS investigator observed dogs at the Respondent's property. As a result, ACAS issued a Warning Notice to Correct Violation for failure to treat animals humanely under Alachua County Code Chapter 72.10, for failure to vaccinate under Alachua County Code Chapter 72.22, and for failure to obtain a county license under Alachua County Code 72.23. In accordance with Florida Statutes §828.073, ACAS impounded one dog belonging to the Respondent on 7/24/19. A veterinary examination found the dog to be suffering from neglect. ACAS further issued a Mandatory Veterinarian Examination to the Respondent to obtain veterinary care within 10 days for any animals remaining in the Respondent's custody. The County's Petition for Custody of Animal was heard in County Court on September 11, 2019.

The County Attorney seeks authority to file a Petition for Custody of Animal due to the neglect of one dog belonging to the Respondent. In accordance with Florida Statutes §828.073, ACAS impounded one dog belonging to the Respondent on August 16, 2019. A veterinary examination found the dog to be suffering from neglect. The County's Petition for Custody of Animal was heard in County Court on September 18, 2019.
