



Ultimate Bullfighters or UBF was created over a decade ago to promote the sport of freestyle bullfighting, a derivative of the western sports & rodeo.

In freestyle bullfighting, a bullfighter competes for 60 seconds against a fighting bull predominantly of Spanish descent in an effort to score points for maneuvers performed during the 1 minute competition. Unlike traditional bullfighting, the animals are not harmed or killed. Bullfighters are judged solely on their ability to perform dangerous stunts as close to the bull as possible without getting hit.

With a rapidly gaining fan base due to the high action of the sport itself, the UBF is positioned to become a huge phenomenon in the western sports world and beyond.

ANIMAL WELFARE

In Our Events, Cowboys Share The Limelight With The Event Livestock. For A Cowboy To Compete At The Highest Level, The Livestock Also Must Be In Peak Condition. Both Are Athletes In Their Own Right. The Very Nature Of Event Requires A Working Relationship, And In Some Events A Partnership, Between The Cowboys And Animal Athletes.

Premier Bulls Tour (PBT) Athletes Value Their Animals, As Do The PBT Stock Contractors That Provide The Livestock For The Events. Like Most People, PBT Members Believe Animals Should Be Provided Proper Care And Treatment. The PBT And Its Members Value Their Animals And Staunchly Protect Them With Specifically Created Rules.

Like A Well-Conditioned Athlete, An Animal Can Perform Well Only If It Is Healthy. Any Cowboy Will Tell You He Takes Home A Paycheck Only When The Animal Is In Top Form. Stock Contractors, The Ranchers Who Raise And Provide Livestock To Rodeos, Also Have An Obvious Financial Interest In Keeping The Animals Healthy. Simple Logic Dictates That No Sensible Businessperson Would Abuse An Animal That Is Expected To Perform In The Future.

Anyone Who Attends A PBT Event Can Be Assured That The Greatest Care Has Been Taken To Prevent Injury To Animals Or Contestants.

Animal Welfare Is A Major And Ongoing Initiative Of The PBT. Not Only Does The Association Have Rules To Ensure The Proper Care And Treatment Of Event Livestock, But It Also Has Several Veterinary Advisory Panels And Periodically Hosts Educational Seminars For Veterinarians And Event Industry Members. To Coordinate Its Animal Welfare Efforts, The PBT Employs A Full-Time Animal Welfare Coordinator To Oversee Internal And Public Education Programs
