Commissioner Cornell moved the following:

1. Under the PPP statute direct staff to prepare a draft 90 day RFP requesting competing proposals in response to the AMJ Inc. unsolicited offer and bring that RFP back to the Board of County Commissioners in a meeting to review and discuss prior to issuing it January.
2. Ask AMJ Group, Inc. at the same meeting to present what their thoughts are that they sent over in this proposal so the Board can understand their timeframe and what their vision is based on the County vision.
3. If the Board decides to proceed in January with issuing an RFP staff is directed to schedule a minimum of at least two charrettes to discuss the Board of County Commissioners downtown master plan. The Board would have 90 days to accomplish this. The City of Gainesville, School Board and the Children's Trust should be invited to share their goals and planning.

2nd Commissioner Alford

Commissioner Prizzia, County Manager Lieberman, and Commissioner Alford presented comments.

Chair Wheeler recognized Nathan Skop, Mike Warren, Gainesville City Commissioner Hayes-Santos, and Don Den Glemming who presented comments.

The motion carried 5-0.




