**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, will consider the adoption of an ordinance at its meeting to be held in Room 209 of the Alachua County Administration Building, 12 Southeast First Street, Gainesville, Florida, on the 9th day of November, 2021, at 11:30 o'clock a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard. Said ordinance being titled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO THE FLORIDA CONSTITUTION (ARTICLE VIII, SECTION 1, PARAGRAPH (E)); PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR A TITLE; PROVIDING FOR PURPOSE AND INTENT; PROVIDING REVISED COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS BASED ON 2020 CENSUS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THE REVISED DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 124.02(1) OF THE FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR FILING OF COPIES AND FURNISHING OF MINUTES; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
