foundry.

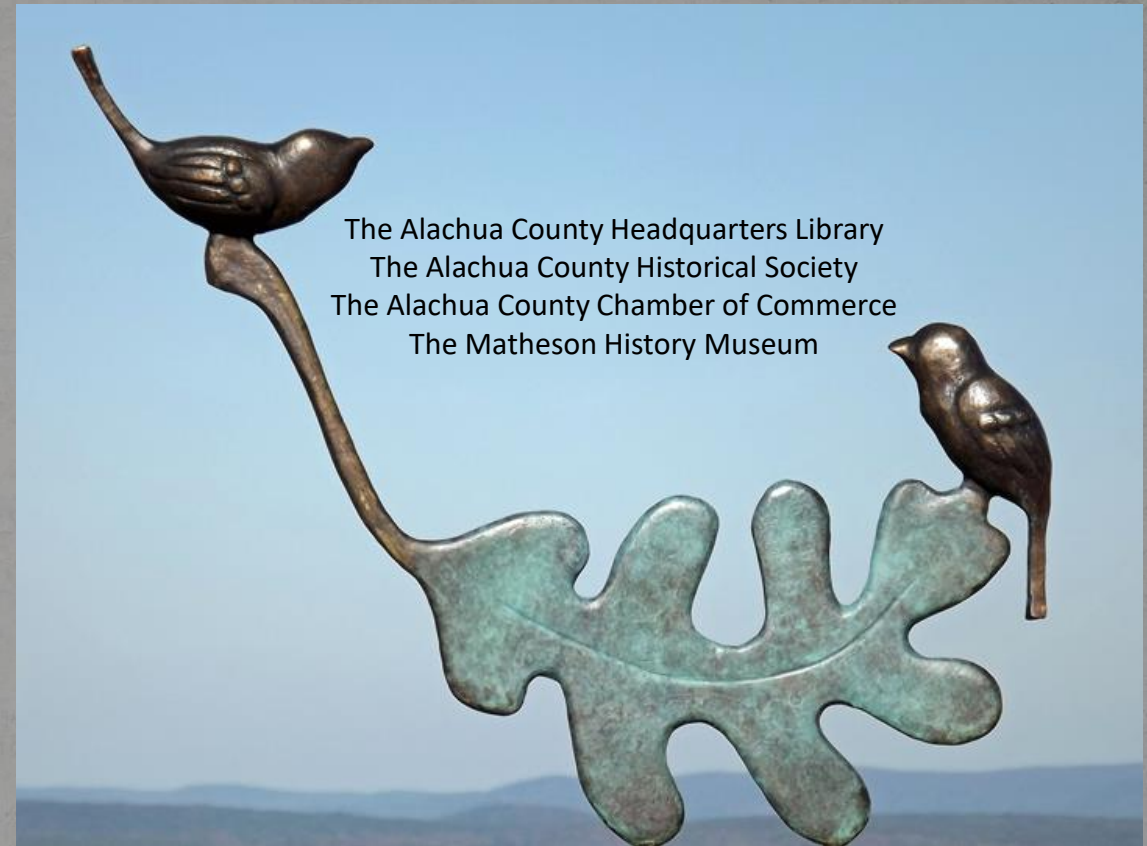

I have always maintained that Public Art should perpetuate a generosity of spirit with its' community.

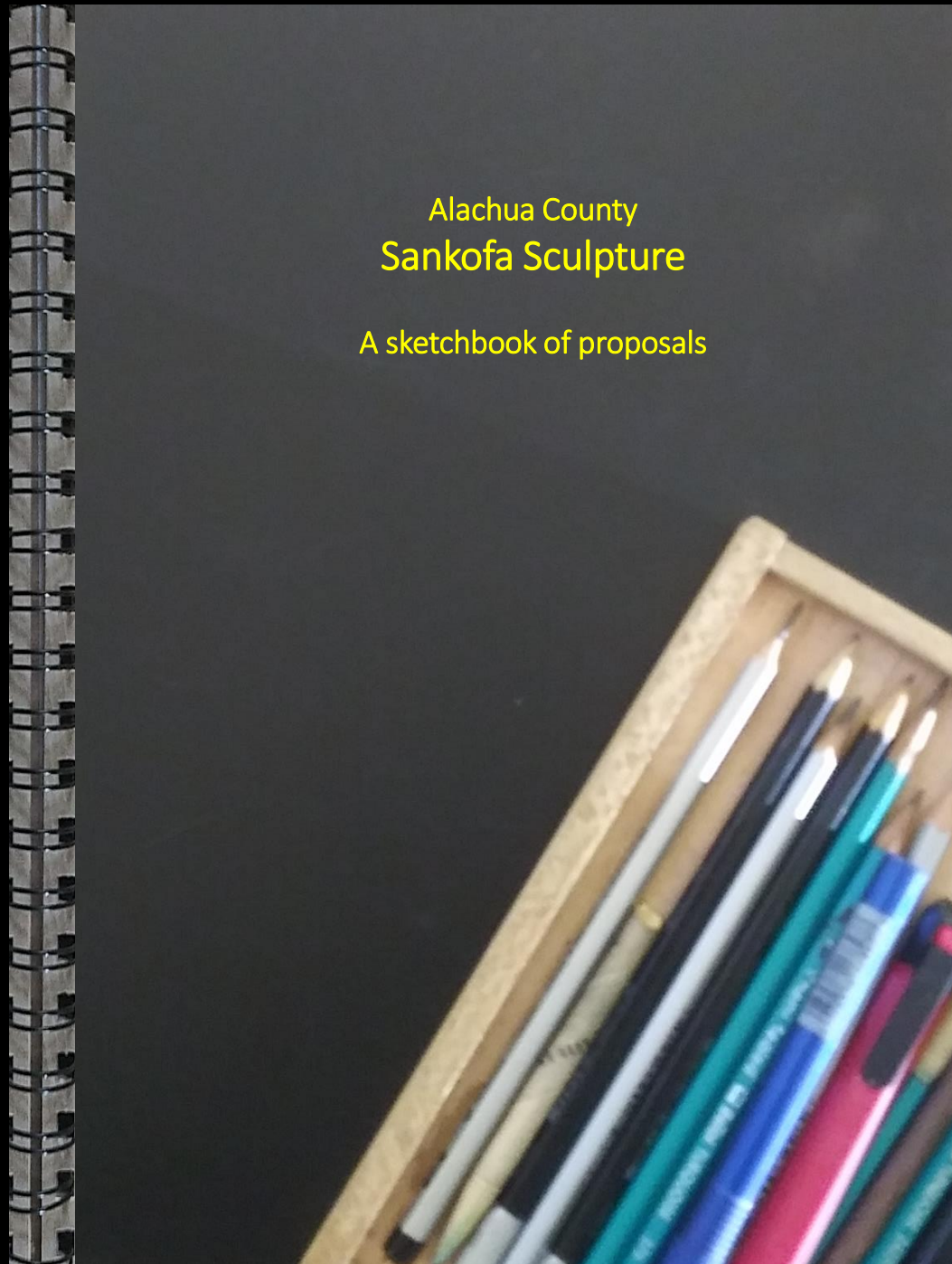
Viewers should discover the unexpected, finding content that applies to another part of their lives and thus, the art becomes a co-creation.

Dr. Patricia Hilliard-Nunn (1963-2020) was a teacher, scholar, artist and community activist who taught African and African American history at the University of Florida and lectured at many venues throughout Alachua County.

Her research focused attention on the history of racial violence in Alachua County and sparked the creation of the Alachua County Community Remembrance Project. In her lectures, she often emphasized the importance of “Sankofa,” an Akan symbol and concept from West Africa which means “embrace your past and make it useful today.”

*Commemorative signage scripted within an elliptical shape....as the Sankofa bird is often depicted protecting its precious egg offspring

no maintenance.

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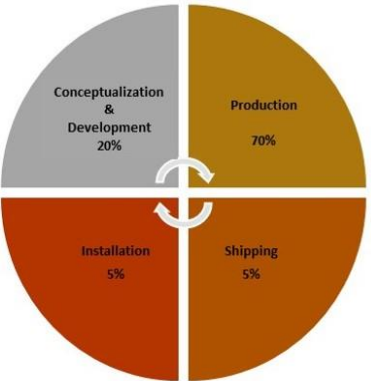


Plaster pattern prepared for casting process

Project Budget



Conceptualization and Development- Through the discussion and use of visual materials, (which will include drawings, and in some instances maquettes), the parameters of project, i.e. scale, placement, estimated production schedule and projected requirements will be agreed upon. (Administrative documentation is inclusive)

Production- The artist and team will make a full scale plaster model/s or prototype, which will be delivered to several art foundries for casting into bronze. Upon completion of comprehensive foundry work, the sculpture will be shipped to the artists' studio where the casting process will continue. This will include welding, fabrication, metal finishing and patination.

Shipping / Transportation- Contracted Freight Handler/s (Insured/Bonded) **Site Preparation-** Specific preparations will be necessary at the installation site.

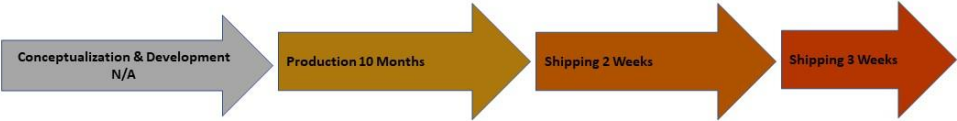
Installation- Due to the scale and weight of the artwork, it may/not be necessary to utilize specialty equipment/riggers to help perform this site-specific installation

1. Liability insurance, permits, engineering certificates, customs fees, incidentals are calculated in "Production".
2. All requisite supplies, materials as well as associated costs for site clean-up are included in "Installation".
