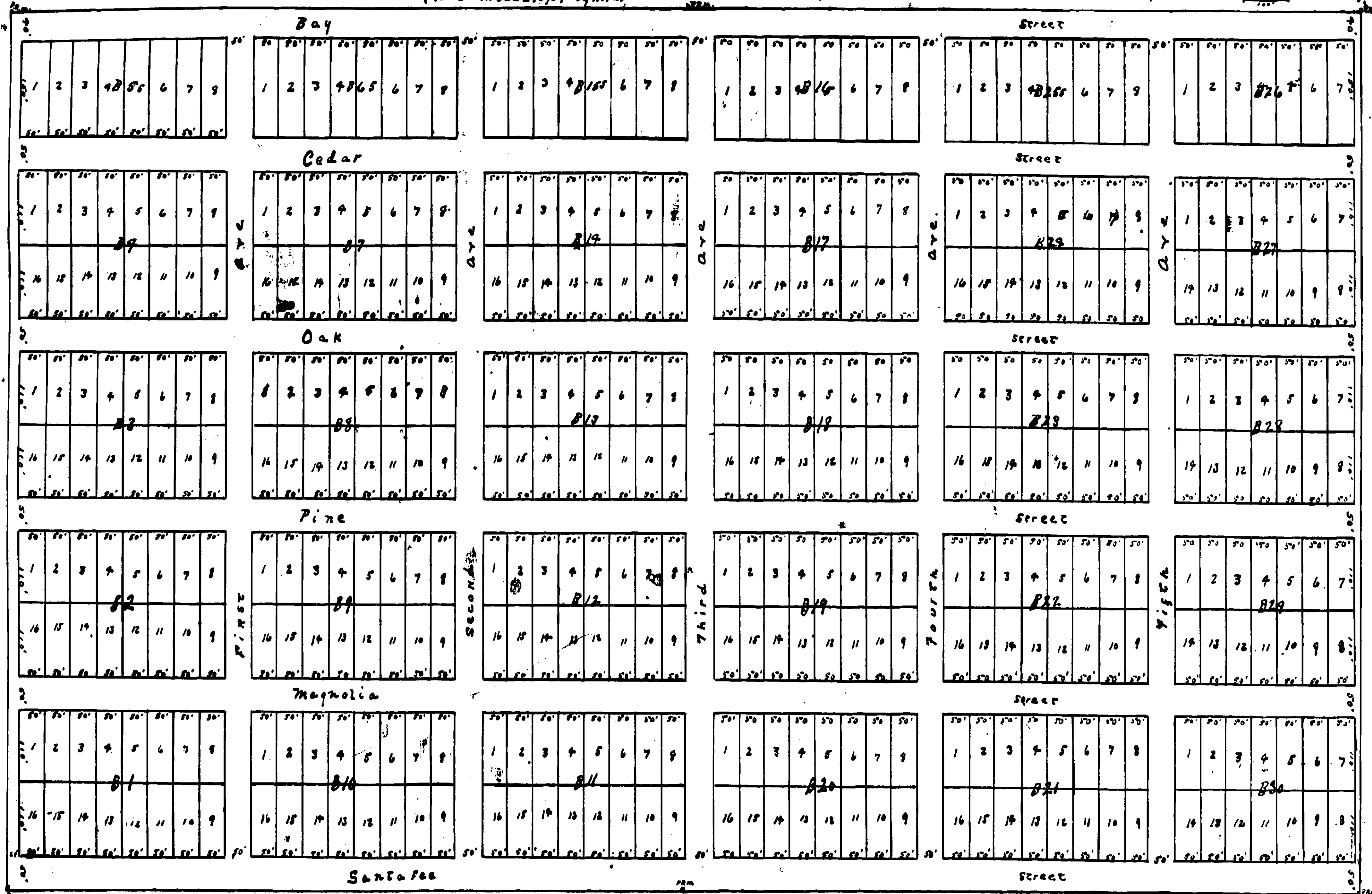


HIGH-SPRINGS MANOR
