Impact on capacity of Bars and Restaurants

If the enterprise obtains more than 50% of its income from the sale of alcoholic beverages they shall suspend the sale of such beverages immediately. Restaurants are limited to 50% capacity and shall limit parties to 10 each and ensure a 6 foot distance between each group.

Bars close for 30 days. Restaurants open from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. table service only. Minimum 6 feet between tables and no groups larger than 10. Take out and delivery allowed. 50% permitted occupancy load.

Food Service Establishments may sell alcohol in sealed containers for off site consumption as long as food is sold with the alcohol. On premises food consumption is prohibited, but take out allowed.

Withdrew conflicting issues regarding on premises consumption of alcohol and food.

Allows restaurants to sell take out per the governor's order. Does not allow for in person consumption.

Bars, pubs and Nightclubs may have only take out. Restaurants may allow for dine in with 25% of building occupancy, outdoor seating allowed with social distancing and limit on 10 people per party. Bar counters closed.

Same restrictions as Governor's order

Restaurants at 50% indoor capacity, outdoor seating permissible with social distancing. Bars may open with seated service under the same capacity limitations.
