*FL residents: 10,902*

*Non-FL residents: 94*

*Median Age: 25*

**115,075** People Tested

*9.5% of People tested have been Positive*

**222,418+** Tests Performed

*4.9% of tests performed have been Positive*

**528** Residents Hospitalized

**78** Deaths

*(October 22<sup>nd</sup> – November 4<sup>th</sup>)*

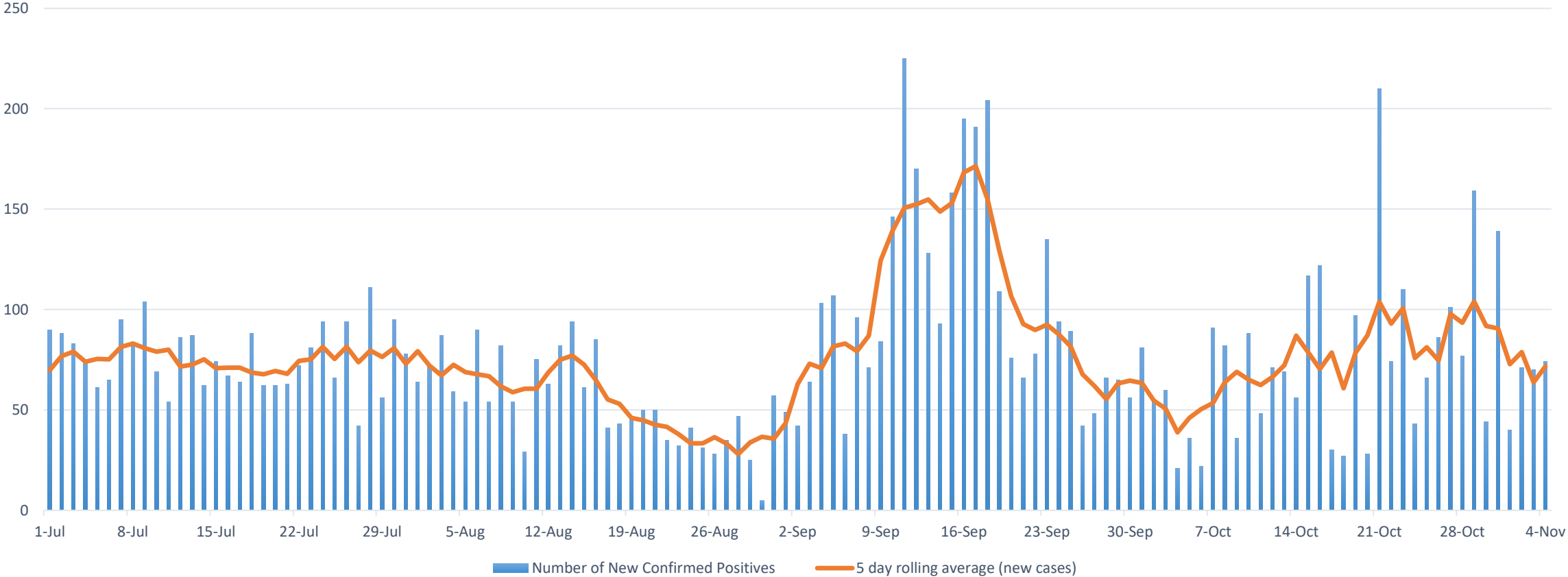
**19,893** Tests Processed

**5.8%** Positivity Rate

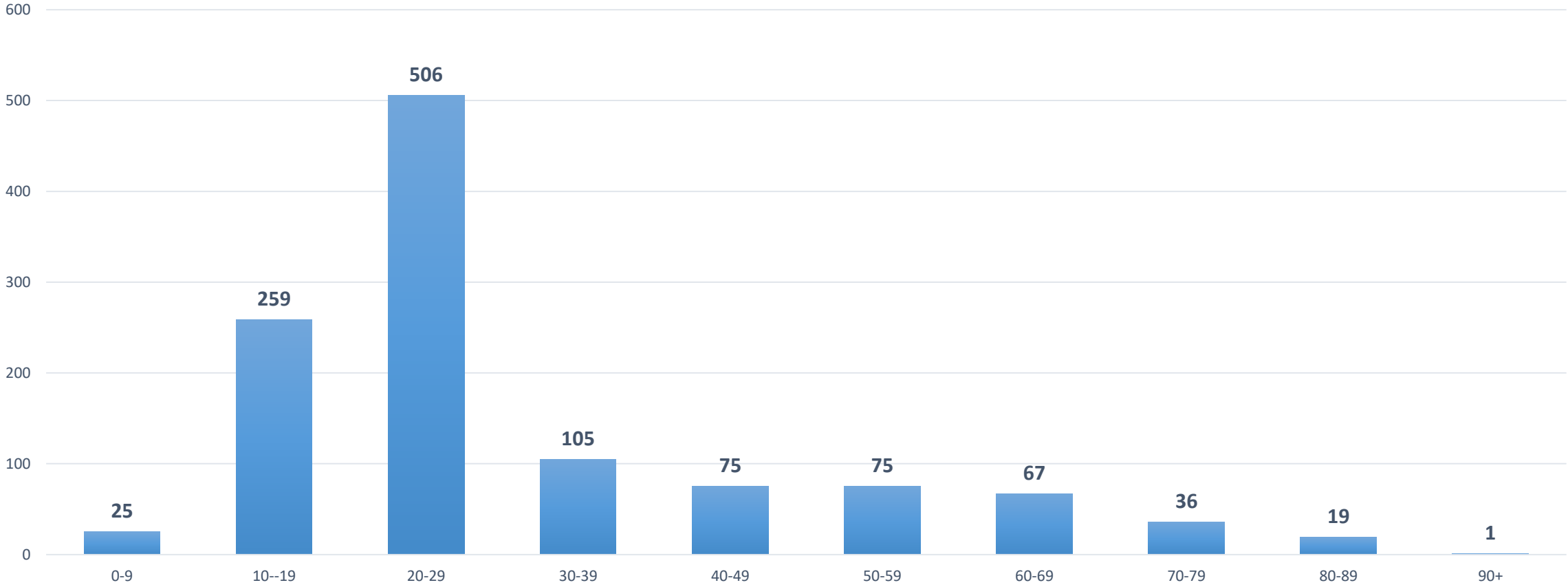

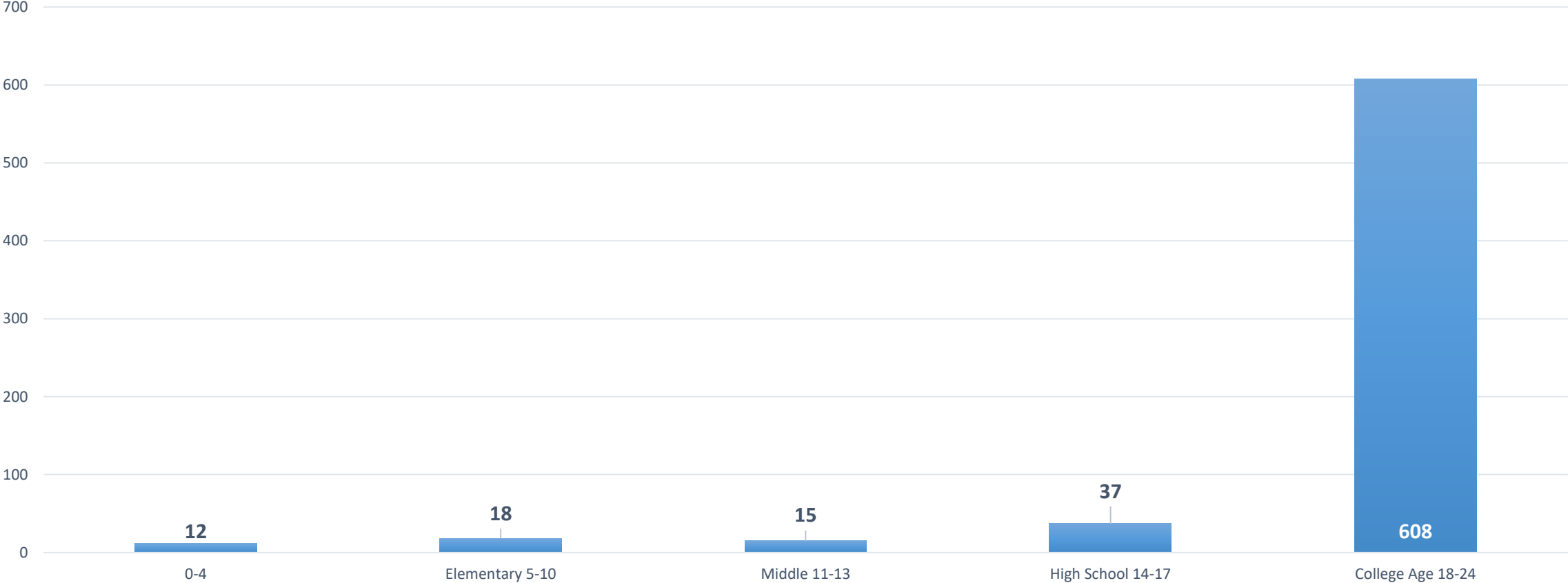
Cases by Age 10/22/11/4

Robust testing program in place for at-risk healthcare workers, including emerging antibody testing*

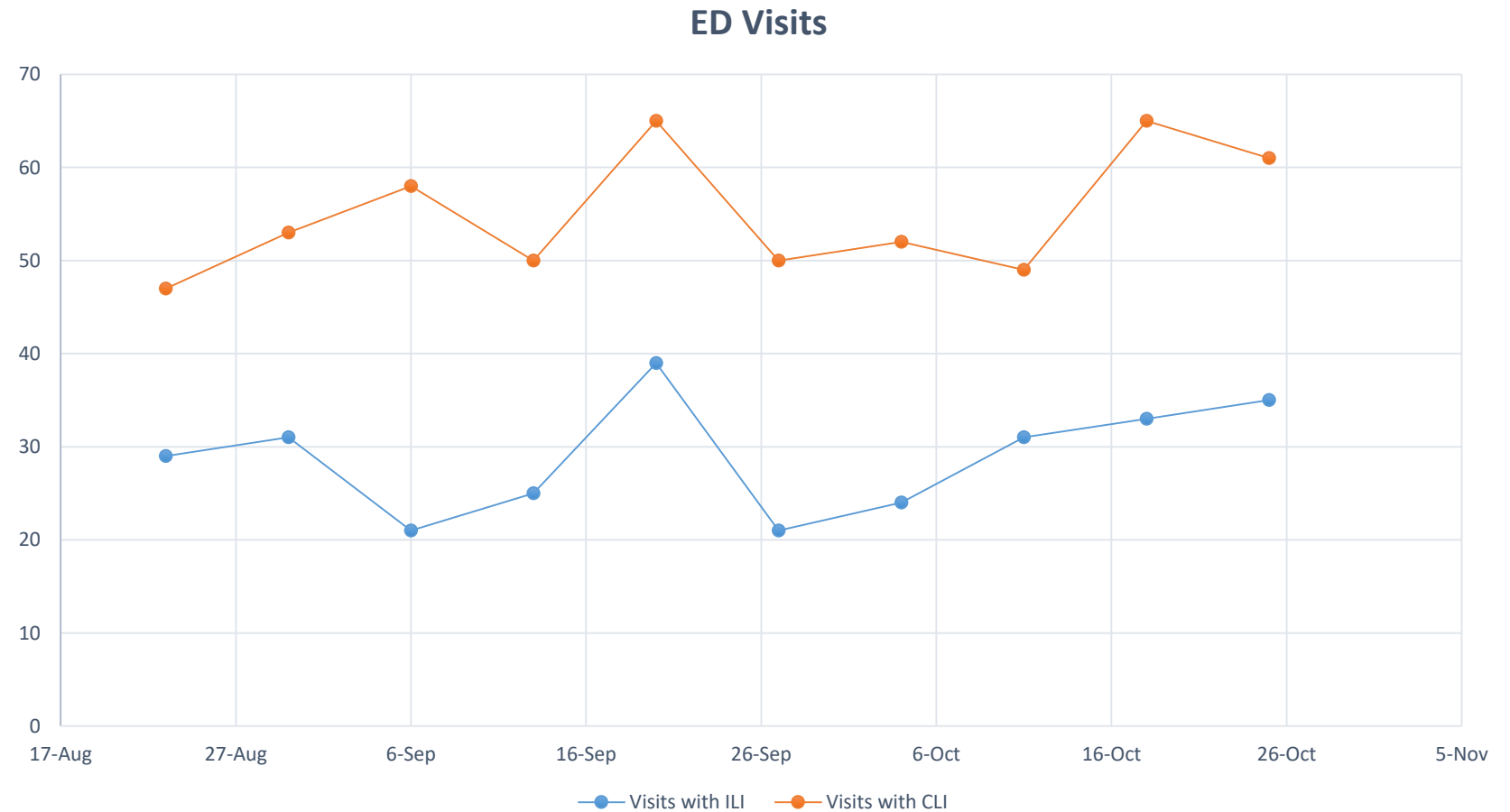

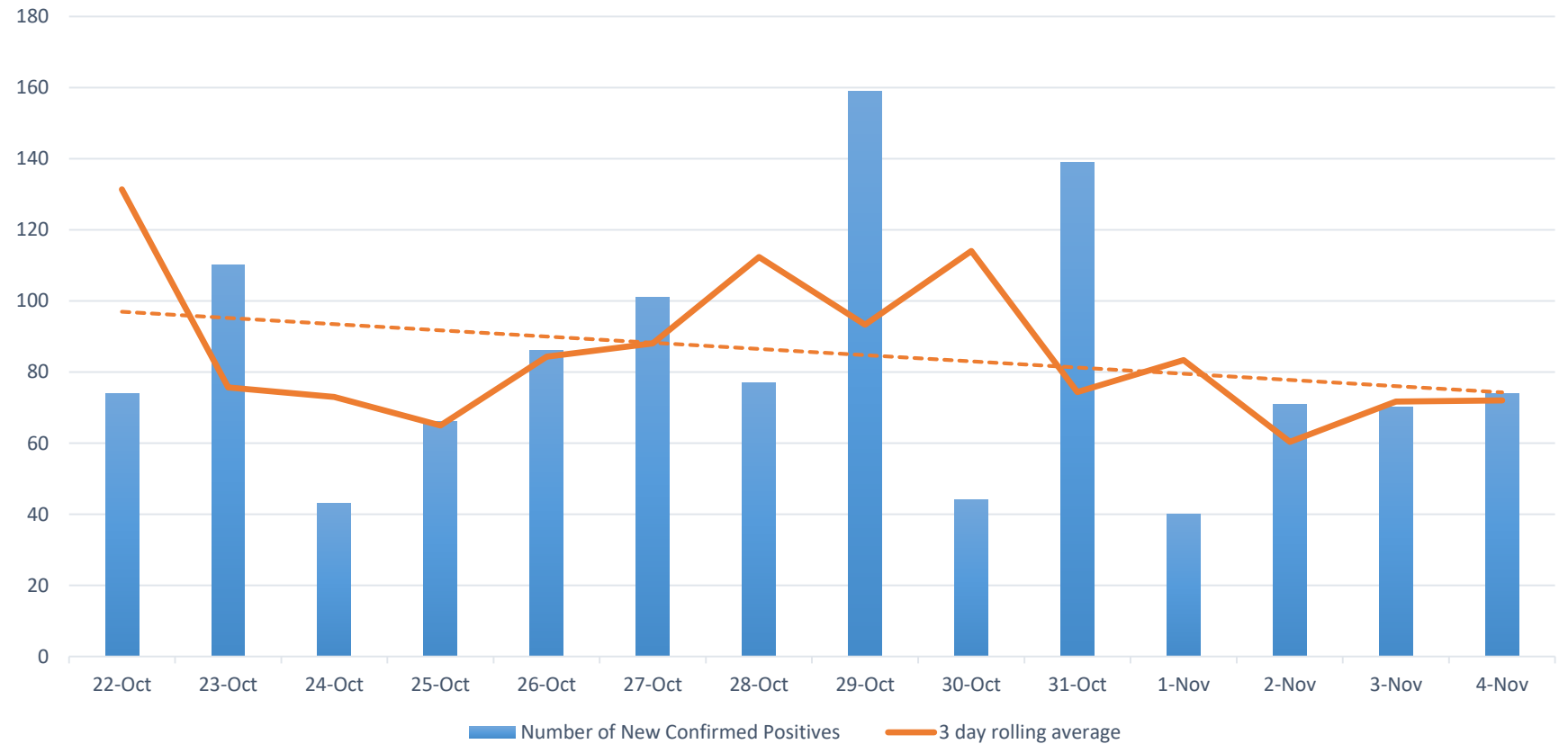

*Downward trajectory of documented cases within a 14-day period*

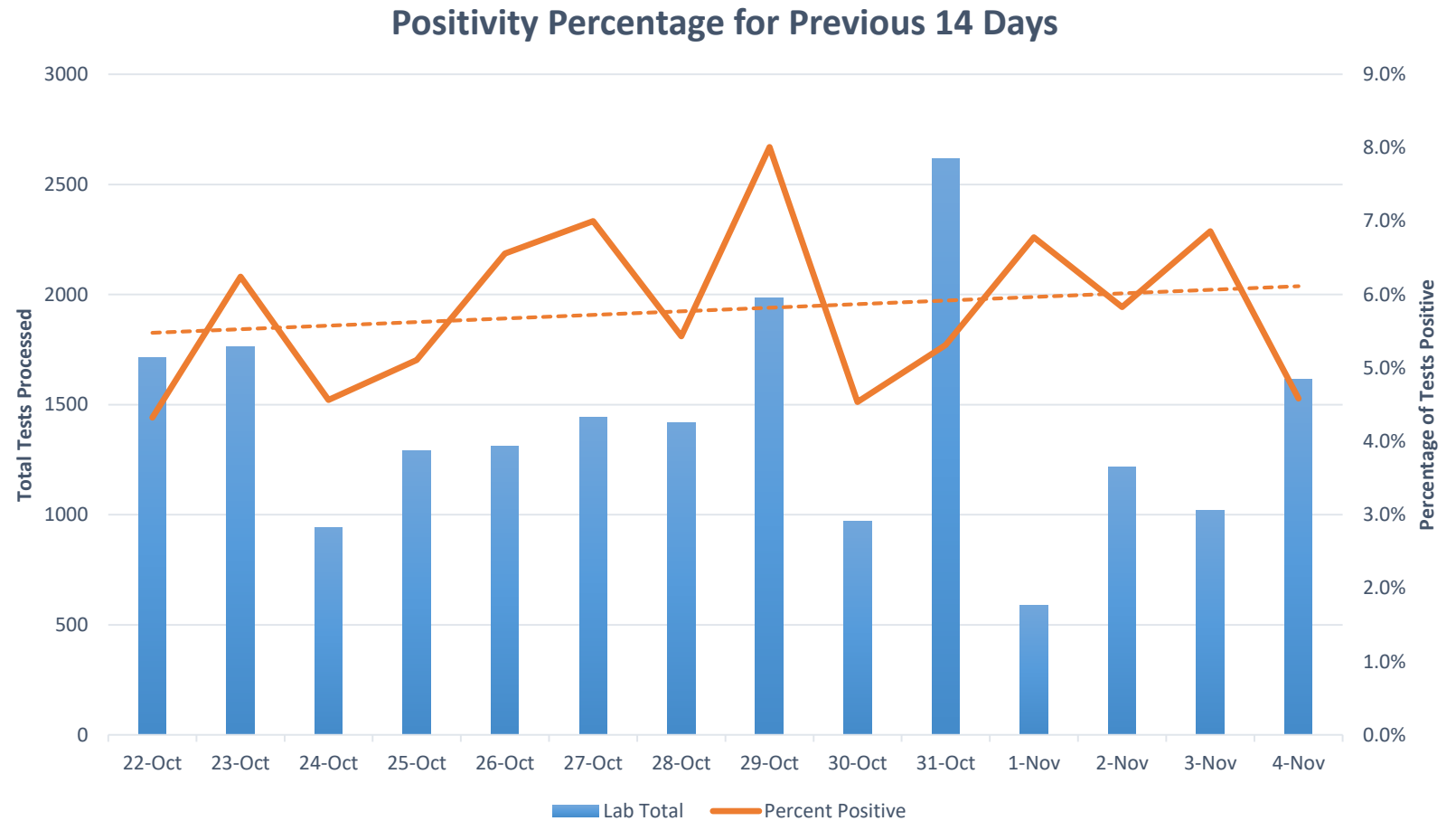

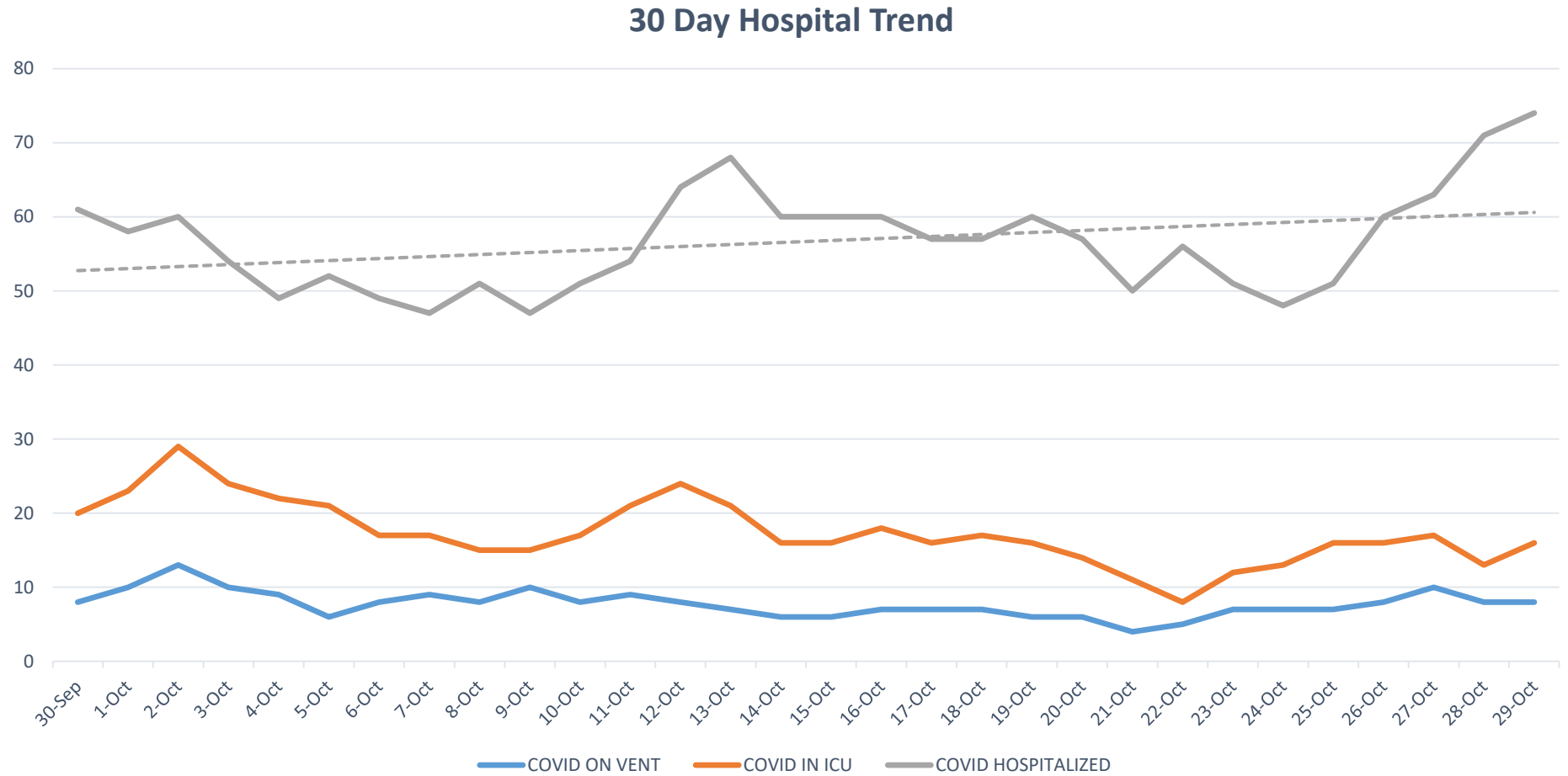


