- WETLANDS:** SIGNIFICANT NATURAL WETLANDS LOCATED WITHIN THE PROJECT LIMITS WILL BE LOCATED WITHIN THE CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT AREA

- THE DEVELOPMENT PROPOSES TO RETAIN 43.18% OF THE ORIGINAL TREE CANOPY WHICH EXCEEDS THE MINIMUM RETENTION REQUIREMENT OF 5%. THE CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT AREA WILL PROTECT THE MOST SIGNIFICANT VEGETATION LOCATED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE PROJECT SITE.
- ULDC 406.101 DISCHARGE TO PROTECTED AREAS**
- SMF 2-B WILL DISCHARGE TO THE PROPOSED FLOODPLAIN COMPENSATORY DEPRESSION OVER A TRAPEZOIDAL WEIR WHERE IT WILL STAGE UP AND ULTIMATELY DISCHARGE TO THE CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT AREA.

- ALL AREAS WITH AN " * " ARE LOCATED WITHIN THE STRATEGIC ECOSYSTEM AND ARE BEING PRESERVED WITHIN THE 88.23 ACRE CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT AREA.
- IN ADDITION TO THE 88.23 ACRE CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT AREA, THERE WILL BE APPROXIMATELY 28.23 ACRES OF STORMWATER MANAGEMENT AREA. HOWEVER, THIS AREA IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY OPEN SPACE AREA CALCULATIONS.

- SHOULD ANY BUFFER BE REQUIRED ALONG ADJACENT PARCELS DURING FINAL REVIEW, A BUFFER WILL BE PROVIDED PER ULDC 407.70 (b).
- MULTI-USE PATHS SHALL BE ALLOWED WITHIN CONSERVATION EASEMENT AREAS CONSISTENT WITH THE CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT AREA PLAN AND SUBJECT TO COUNTY APPROVAL. THE ADDITION OF A MULTI-USE PATH WILL NOT REQUIRE AN AMENDMENT TO THE PRELIMINARY DEVELOPMENT PLAN.
- THE WETLAND WITHIN THE TRANSIT SUPPORTIVE AREA (TSA) ADJACENT TO INTERSTATE 75 IS A NON REGULATED MAN MADE WETLAND CREATED DURING THE CONSTRUCTION OF INTERSTATE 75. MODIFICATIONS TO THIS WETLAND WILL MEET ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS AND SJRWMD REQUIREMENTS. ISOLATED WETLANDS WITHIN THE TSA WILL BE REMOVED CONSISTENT WITH ALACHUA COUNTY, ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS, AND SJRWMD REQUIREMENTS.
- CIVIC SPACE, PLAZAS, SQUARES AND COMMON OPEN AREAS WILL BE PROVIDED DURING FINAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN REVIEW OF EACH INTERNAL BLOCK
- A CONSERVATION AREA SETBACK LINE HAS BEEN ADDED ALONG THE WESTERN PORTION OF THE VILLAGE CENTER AND TRANSIT SUPPORTIVE AREA ADJACENT TO THE LAKE KANAPAH CONSERVATION AREA. NO BUILDINGS, PARKING OR VEHICULAR SERVICE AREAS SHALL BE ALLOWED WITHIN THE SETBACK. THE SETBACK LINE SHALL BE 50' AT THE TERMINUS OF SW 30TH AND TRANSITION TO 75' APPROXIMATELY 300' SOUTH OF SW 30TH. THE SETBACK LINE NORTH OF SW 30TH SHALL TRANSITION TO THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT AREA AS SHOWN. A 75' SETBACK SHALL BE PROVIDED ALONG THE WESTERN BOUNDARY SHOULD THE EXTENTS OF THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT AREA BE REDUCED. OPEN SPACES SUCH AS CIVIC SPACES, PLAZAS, SQUARES, STORMWATER MANAGEMENT AREAS AND MULTI-USE PATHS SHALL BE PERMITTED WITHIN THE SETBACK AND WILL BE PROVIDED BETWEEN BUILDINGS AND THE SETBACK. LANDSCAPED AREAS SHALL BE PLANTED WITH NATIVE VEGETATION. EXISTING VEGETATION WILL BE USED TO THE GREATEST EXTENT FEASIBLE.
- NATURE TRAILS ARE ALLOWED IN THE CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT AREA
