You are further notified the Alachua County is ready, willing, and able to perform and follow all of the terms, covenants, and conditions of the Option Contract.

Pursuant to the Option Contract, Paragraph 6 "Inspections," Alachua County's Inspection Period commences upon the delivery of this Notice.
