THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 11215 BETWEEN ALACHUA COUNTY AND GREEN MAINTENANCE & CLEANING INC FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY MOWING -BID 19-214

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 11215, made and entered into on _______, 2021, by and between Alachua County, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as "County", and Green Maintenance & Cleaning, Inc, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor", and collectively the County and the Contractor are hereinafter referred to as the "Parties".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, in 2019, the County issued Bid#19-214 seeking Contractors to provide Firm Fixed Prices for Annual Right-Of-Way Mowing in Alachua County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, after evaluating and considering all timely responses to Bid #19-214 the County identified the Contractor as the top ranked firm; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Bid #19-214 the Parties hereto previously entered into the *Agreement for Contractual Services between Alachua County and Green Maintenance and Cleaning Inc.* dated March 12, 2019 (the "Agreement") for the provision of Annual Right-Of-Way Mowing; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into the First Amendment to the Agreement (the "First Amendment"), dated September 24, 2019, through which the County elected to exercise its first option to renew the Term of the Agreement for a one year period commencing October 1, 2019 and continuing through September 30, 2020 ("First Renewal Option Term"), add additional service areas to the Scope of Work, and to adjust the Annual Contract Price to account for the additional scope; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into the Second Amendment to the Agreement (the "Second Amendment"), dated September 22, 2020, through which the County elected to exercise its second option to renew the Term of the Agreement for a one year period continuing through September 30, 2021 ("Second Renewal Option Term"), add additional service areas and cycles to the Scope of Work, to reflect the increase to the Alachua County Minimum Wage as mandated by the Alachua County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 22, Article XII ("Wage Ordinance") and to adjust the Annual Contract Price to account for the additional scope; and

WHEREAS, the County has elected to exercise its third and final renewal option to renew the Term of the Agreement for a 1-year period commencing October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022, to amend the Alachua County Minimum Wage as mandated by the Alachua County Wage Ordinance and to amend the Agreement to add a clause which acknowledges the employment eligibility requirements via the U.S. Department of Homeland Security E-Verify System as set forth herein; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to amend the Agreement as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree to amend the Agreement, dated 3/12/2019, as follows:

- 1. SECTION #1 of the Agreement, Term, is amended in its entirety to read:
 - 1.1.The County has elected to exercise its third and final option to renew the Term of the Agreement. Accordingly, the Term of the Agreement is renewed for the period commencing upon of this Third Amendment by the Parties and continuing through and ending September 30, 2022 (the "Third and Final Renewal Option Term"), unless earlier terminated as provided herein.
 - 1.2. The County's performance and obligation to pay under this Agreement is contingent upon a specific annual appropriation by the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners ("Board"). The Parties hereto understand that this Agreement is not a commitment of future appropriations. Therefore, the continuation of this Agreement beyond the end of any fiscal year shall be subject to both the

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appropriation and the availability of funds in accordance with Chapter 129, Florida Statutes, and that the failure of the Board to do so shall not constitute a breach or default of this Agreement.

2. **SECTION** #5 of the Agreement, *Alachua County Minimum Wage*, is amended in its entirety to read:

5. Alachua County Minimum Wage.

- 5.1.The Work performed through this Agreement is considered covered services under Chapter 22, Article XII, of the Alachua County Code of Ordinances ("Wage Ordinance"), which establishes 'a government minimum wage for certain contractors and subcontractors providing selected services to Alachua County government. "Covered Employees," as defined in Sec. 22.12-101 of the Wage Ordinance, are those employees directly involved in providing covered services pursuant to this Agreement.
- 5.2.The Contractor shall provide certification, the form of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 3, to the County that it pays each of its employees the Alachua County Government Minimum Wage, as may be amended by the County on or before October 1st of each year, as well as ensuring that it will require the same of its subcontractors throughout the duration of this Agreement.
- 5.3.The Contractor shall prominently display a copy of the Wage Ordinance where it is easily seen by covered employees and supply to covered employees upon request. Additionally, the Contractor is responsible to make any person submitting a bid for a subcontract for covered services aware of the requirements.
- 5.4.Failure to comply with the provisions of the Wage Ordinance will be deemed a breach of contract and authorize the County to withhold payment of funds in accordance with Chapter 218, Florida Statutes.

- 5.5.The Contractor will include the necessary provisions in subcontracts to ensure compliance. However, the County shall not be deemed a necessary, or indispensable, party in any litigation between the contractor and subcontractor.
- 3. SECTION #31 of the Agreement, U.S. Department of Homeland Security E-Verify System, is added to read:
 - 31. U.S. Department of Homeland Security E-Verify System.
 - 31.1. The Contractor shall utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system to verify the employment eligibility of all new employees hired by the Contractor during the term of the Agreement. The E-Verify system is located at <u>https://www.uscis.gov/E-Verify</u>.
 - 31.2. The Contractor shall expressly require any subcontractors performing work or providing services pursuant to the County's Agreement to utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system to verify the employment eligibility of all new employees hired by the subcontractor during the term of the Agreement. The E-Verify system is located at https://www.uscis.gov/E-Verify.
- 4. This Third Amendment shall take effect upon expiration of the original Agreement.
- 5. SAVE and EXCEPT as expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the original Agreement between the parties, dated 3/12/2019, including any amendments thereto, shall be and remain in full force and effect. In the event any of the previous amendments to the Agreement conflict with this Third Amendment, the provisions of this Third Amendment shall prevail.

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Getting paper copies
