I. COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY.

C All Coverages

- 1 The Vendor shall provide a Certificate of Insurance to the County with a Thirty (30) day notice of cancellation. The certificate shall indicate if cover is provided under a "claims made" or "per occurrence" form. If any cover is provided under a claims made form the certificate will show a retroactive date, which should be the same date of the contract or purchase order (original if contract is renewed) or prior.

V. SUBCONTRACTORS

Vendors shall include all subcontractors as insured under its policies. All coverages for subcontractors shall be subject to all of the requirements stated herein.

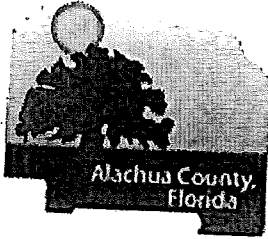
