## Declaring September 2022, as "Suicide Prevention Month" in Alachua County, Florida

Whereas,	suicide is a significant public health issue and we can all work together to support and protect our community; and
Whereas,	in the United States there were almost 45,979 deaths by suicide during 2020; and
Whereas,	in our country, suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death for those aged 15-24, and the 10th leading cause of death for people of all ages; and
Whereas,	3113 people in Florida died by suicide in 2020; it is the 8 <sup>th</sup> leading cause of death in our state; and
Whereas,	each death by suicide directly impacts numerous family members, friends, loved ones, and by extension the entire community; and
Whereas,	culturally specific and responsive mental health services are a critical component of supporting communities; and
Whereas,	the newly launched 988 Crisis and Suicide Lifeline will make it easier for people to access care; and
Whereas,	the Alachua County Crisis Center offers 24-hour crisis intervention support through phone, face-to-face and telehealth options; and
Whereas,	the Alachua County Crisis Center is committed to reducing the stigma that surrounds the topic of suicide by raising awareness and providing education and training on suicide prevention; and
Whereas,	all individuals should be aware of the warning signs and feel empowered to seek help for themselves, loved ones, co-workers, friends; and
Whereas,	no single suicide prevention effort will be sufficient, everyone is asked to join and take a stand to prevent suicide.
