## RESOLUTION 2022-86

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE LEVY OF GENERAL COUNTY PURPOSE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2022 TAX YEAR; APPROVING PROPOSED MILLAGE RATES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 2022-67 approving the proposed millage rate necessary to fund the tentative general County budget; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to law and utilizing the rates established in the said resolution, by August 18, 2022, the Alachua County Property Appraiser mailed a Notice of Proposed Property Taxes to each taxpayer listed on the current year's assessment roll; and,

WHEREAS, the said Notice of Proposed Property Taxes advised the recipients of a public hearing, as required by Florida Statute 200.065, to be conducted by the Board of County Commissioners on this date for consideration of its tentative general County budget and the proposed millage necessary to fund the said budget; and,

WHEREAS, the public hearing has been held as specified in the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes and in accordance with applicable law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA;

1. That the following proposed millage rate to fund a tentative general County budget is hereby approved for further consideration in accordance with applicable law:

General Fund 7.7622 mills

- 2. The millage rate levied herein is greater than the rolled back rate of 7.2684 mills by 7.02%.
- 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
