**Whereas,** Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17<sup>th</sup> through 23<sup>rd</sup> as Constitution Week.

**Now, therefore, through the authority vested in me by the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, I do hereby proclaim September 17<sup>th</sup> through 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2019 as "Constitution Week" in Alachua County, Florida.**
