Archer Hawthorne and Waldo and collection of this assessment pursuant to the tax bill collection method.

The hearing will be held at 5.01 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard on Theoday September 10, 2019 in the Alachua County Administration Building, 12 Southeast First Street Second Floor, Room 209, Cameroville, Florida, for the purpose of receiving public comment on the proposed as sessment. All affected property owners have a right to appear at the hearing and to file written objections with the County before or during the hearing. Ha person decides to appeal any decision unade by the Board of County Commissioners with respect to any matter considered at the hearing, such person will need a record of the proceedings and may need to ensure that a verbatim record is made, including the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be made. The amount of the annual fire assessment imposed against each property is based on a two-freed apportionment method whereby a portion of the County's annual fire department bridget is allocated equally among all parcels on a per parcel basis (Tier 1), and the renaturing portion of the budget to be funded through the assessment is apportioned based on the value of structures on each parcel (Tier 2), measured in increments of \$5,000 each of which comprise an equivalent benefit mix (EBU). Undeveloped property is not subject to Tier 2.



The fire service non ad valorem assessment will be collected on the annual ad valorem tax bill unailed in November of each year that the assessment is imposed. Failure to pay the assessment will cause a fax certificate to be issued against the property in accordance with the provisions of Florida law, which may result in a loss of title.
