

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 197 3632. Florida Statutes, that the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, (Board), will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, September 10, 2019, at 5 01 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, Room 209, 2nd floor of the Alachua County Administration Building, 12 South East 1st Street, Gainesville, Florida, to consider the imposition of non-ad-valorem assessments against certain improved residential properties located within the Alachua County Municipal Services Benefit Unit which serves the unincorporated area of Alachua County, to fund residential solid waste collection, disposal and recycling services to such properties and to authorize collection of such assessments on the annual ad valorem tax bill. This assessment will be imposed by the Board and will be collector by the Alachua County Tax Collector.

The property subject to the non-oid valorem assessment for solid waste collection, disposal and recycling is located within the unincorporated area of Alachua County. The proposed assessment includes all residential properties with less than ten units within the area depicted on the map below. The area subject to the assessment is the portion of unincorporated Alachua County which is inside the rectangle, and the subdivisions represented by stars.



The amount of the assessment to be imposed against each parcel of properly and the legal documentation relating to the assessments are available for veiring electronically at the Alachua County Waste Collection office at 5820 NW 120th Lane. Gainesvide, Flonda, between the nours of 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.

The proposed annual non-ad valorem assessment for Universal solid waste collection disposal and recycling for the fiscal year October 1, 2019, through September 30, 2020, is \$119,30 per residence with a mini cart, \$137,96 per recidence with a 36 gallon cart, \$191,00 per solid per solid
