#### Abstract

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF SURPLUS BICYCLES, TO UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA, TO BE USED TO PROVIDE PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 274.05, Florida Statutes, surplus tangible property which is obsolete or the continued use of which serves no useful function may, within the reasonable discretion of the County, having consideration for the best interests of the County be offered to other governmental units for donation, and

WHEREAS, the Alachua County Fire Rescue Department procured twelve (12) bicycles for the Reserve Bike Team Program which was eliminated in FY2010, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that this property is surplus property within the meaning of the foregoing statute, and

WHEREAS, the University of Florida through the University of Florida Police Department manages the Gator Medical Response Unit, for the purpose of providing public safety services, and has made a written request for the property, and

WHEREAS, the property will serve public or community interest and welfare.
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA;

1. The Board finds, determines and declares that the recitals in the preamble are true and correct, and hereby incorporates them by reference.
2. The Board hereby authorizes the transfer of the equipment to the University of Florida .
3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
