EXAMPLE OPERATION AND MANAGEMENT PLAN

At beginning of each day, first check premises, open gates and restrooms.

At end of each day, check premises for issues and/or unauthorized individuals. Close and lock restrooms.

a. Process

Daily Operation:

At the beginning of each shift, each employee will check in with their immediate supervisor for daily task assignments and to obtain any relevant important news that concern facilities and/or specific building locations.

After daily check-ins, each employee will gather necessary equipment and materials and then proceed to their respective assigned facilities and locations.

- If any matters that are of concern that need immediate attention, will be reported to the immediate supervisor at the end of the shift.
- Supervisors will make regular routine checks and on occasion random checks on the progress and quality of employee task completion.

The staff will have caution signs posted outside the front door at the beginning of cleaning session.

Cleaning (Objects and Surfaces)

Personnel will cause an object to be free from contamination litter, pollution, and/or soil by using and performing the janitorial service industry standards best practices & techniques to accomplish and assigned tasks.

Chemicals and Cleaning Agents

When using cleaning agents, personnel will follow the instructional use of the manufacturer including obtaining the recommended dilution rate for the concentrated forms.

Spot Clean (Surfaces)

For surface items that are difficult to remove with glass cleaner, stainless steel polish will be utilized as warranted. Personnel will polish stainless steel surfaces with soft clean cloths and glass cleaner. Any excess stainless-steel polish will be removed.

Spot Mop

To remove spills, spots and soil debris from non-carpeted floors that are difficult to remove by dust mopping or vacuuming, personnel will utilize a mop and a detergent solution. Instead of only detergent solution, in clinic/treatment areas and rest rooms, personnel will utilize germicidal detergent solution.

Wash

In the appropriate areas, personnel will employ a detergent solution, a brush and/or towel to remove all soil and dirt debris from the surface of the item being cleaned by rubbing. **EXAMPLE OPERATION AND MANAGEMENT PLAN CONTINUED**

Clean Glass, Mirrors, Windows, Etc.

Personnel will wet the glass with a glass cleaner solution. In the utilization of a clean dry wiper all fingerprints, smears, smudges, spots, and stains will be removed.

Trash and Recyclable Removal

ITB #20-70 Annual Park Restroom Janitorial Services

All waste enroute to be placed in dumpsters will be properly bagged and/or placed into closed containers before disposal. All cardboard containers must be broken down before disposal or deposit for recycling. For the avoidance of damage due to trash bag dragging, appropriate equipment provided for trash removal. For the prevention of bag breakage and leakage, the utilization of heavy duty strength bags & containers will be implemented. All "recyclable" material receptacles will be emptied and returned to their original location. Receptacle liners will be replaced as needed and warranted.

Recyclable materials will be separated in the into the following categories: glass, paper, aluminum cans & plastic bottles. They each shall be transported to their designated disposal areas.

Any litter that cannot be removed by hand will be removed using a carpet vacuum, broom of fine texture, dust mop or damp mop as appropriate. Any items stuck to the floor will be carefully removed using a putty knife or scraper.

Damp Mop (non-carpeted floors)

Personnel will properly prepare the specific areas by completely dust mopping, whereby a lint free, microfiber dust mop will be utilized. Wet floor signs will be positioned appropriately in specific areas. Then a detergent solution will be applied using a mop and a mop pail with wringer.

Wet Clean Floors

The floor will be prepared for sweeping and/or mopping. For safety purposes, a wet floor sign will always be used in the immediate specific area. Staff will remove soil debris, scratches, heel and scuff marks. In areas where floor finish has been applied, a detergent solution wet mop will be employed. Personnel will employ the use of a microfiber mop system to ensure proper disinfection.






