For Bid #20-90 the Solid Waste and Resource Recovery Department recommends accepting the bid by C&D Industrial Maintenance LLC.

Background: The five rural collection centers in Alachua County utilize waste compactors and precrushers to prepare residential solid waste for disposal. Due to heavy use, and the nature of mechanical components, repair work and regular maintenance are required throughout the year. Previously, an agreement with Miner Florida dba Craft Equipment was approved in 2017 with an expiration date of 9/30/2018 and the option to renew for two additional two-year terms. At renewal time, an agreement was not reached with Miner Florida dba Craft Equipment to extend the term. As it became clear that a new vendor would be needed, the Purchasing Department prepared Bid #20-90 for Annual Pre-Crusher Compactors, Stationary Compactor and Container Repair/Maintenance for the benefit of the Waste Management Department.
