

**AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT #10781
BETWEEN ALACHUA COUNTY AND HEALTHY START OF NORTH CENTRAL FLORIDA,
INC.**

THIS **First** AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 10th day of April A.D. 2018 by and between Alachua County, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as "County", and **Healthy Start of North Central Florida, Inc.**, hereinafter referred to as "(Agency)" (collectively referred to as the "Parties"):

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties previously entered into the *Agreement between Alachua County and Healthy Start of North Central Florida, Inc, for the Children's Services Advisory Board Services* dated, January 9, 2018, (the "Agreement") for the provision of funding the NewboRN Nurse Home Visit program ; and,

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by the Parties, the Parties hereby agree to amend the Agreement as follows:






