THIS FIRST A	AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT, made and entered into this day
of	2019, by and between Alachua County, a charter county and politica
subdivision of the State of	of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinafte
referred to as "County",	and Global Tire Recycling of Sumter County, Inc., a Florida for profit
corporation with a princi	ipal business address of 1201 Industrial Drive, Wildwood, Florida 34785
hereinafter referred to as "C	Contractor". Collectively, the County and the Contractor are hereinafter referred
to as the "Parties".	

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Bid #19-72, the Parties hereto previously entered into the *Agreement for Contractual Services Between Alachua County and Global Tire Recycling Inc.* dated April 23, 2019 (the "Agreement"), for the provision of Annual Processing of Waste Tires in Alachua County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the County has elected to exercise its first option to renew the Term of the Agreement through September 30, 2021 ("First Renewal Option Term") and to reflect the increase to the Alachua County Minimum Wage as mandated by the Alachua County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 22, Article III ("Wage Ordinance"); and,

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to amend the Agreement as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by the Parties, the Parties hereby agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

A. SECTION # 1 of the Agreement, Term, is amended in its entirety to read:

- 1.1 The County has elected to exercise its first option to renew the Term of the Agreement. Accordingly, the Term of the Agreement is renewed, effective upon execution, continuing through and ending September 30, 2021 (the "First Renewal Option Term"), unless earlier terminated as provided herein. The County has the option of renewing this Agreement for one (1) additional two (2) year period at the same terms and conditions outlined herein.
- 1.2 The County's performance and obligation to pay under this Agreement is contingent upon a specific annual appropriation by the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners ("Board"). The Parties hereto understand that this Agreement is not a commitment of future appropriations. Therefore, the

continuation of this Agreement beyond the end of any fiscal year shall be subject to both the appropriation and the availability of funds in accordance with Chapter 129, Florida Statutes, and that the failure of the Board to do so shall not constitute a breach or default of this Agreement.

- B. Sub-paragraph 5.1 is amended in their entirety to read as follows:
 - 5.1 Current required Alachua County Government Minimum Wage is \$14.00 per hour when health benefits are provided as the equivalent value of \$2.17 per hour and \$16.17 when health benefits are not provided (collectively, the "Minimum Wage")
- C. This First Amendment shall take effect upon the date of execution by both Parties.
- **D. SAVE and EXCEPT** as expressly amended herein, all other terms and provisions of the Agreement shall be and remain in full force and effect.
