

RESOLUTION 19-XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY,  
FLORIDA TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED  
REVENUE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to receive \$50,000 in unanticipated revenue in the  
Tourism Fund for interest from tourism tax revenue and fund balance; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that development of a multipurpose Event Center is in  
the public interest and is primarily related to the advancement and promotion of tourism in  
Alachua County because the County intends to advertise and promote the multipurpose Event  
Center for national, regional and local sports tournaments and other events that will attract tourists  
to Alachua County; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the expenditure of Tourist Development Tax  
revenue for the following purposes are primarily related to the advancement and promotion of  
tourism in Alachua County, because they are necessary to developing a viable multipurpose Event  
Center in Alachua County: (i) \$26,334.34 for the development of a market demand study and site  
options analysis for a new multi-purpose event center in Alachua County, Florida prepared by  
Victus Advisors; (ii) \$9,049.71 in engineering services provided by DRMP, Inc. regarding the  
development of the Weseman Site (*i.e.*, County owned property adjacent to the County's Solid  
Waste Transfer Station) as a potential location for the County's new combined Fairgrounds and  
Event Center; and (iii) \$13,500.00 for a survey performed by FL Property Consultants Group

for the appraisal of the market value of Canterbury Showplace Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida (the “Board”) hereby approves, adopts and incorporates the recitals set forth above as its legislative findings.
2. By adoption of this resolution, the Board hereby appropriates and permits the revenue and expenditure of the funds as set forth in the Board’s legislative findings and described herein as Attachment A.
- 3 That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
