Dear Sir/Madam:

Please be aware of the following clarifications regarding the above referenced Bid:

## **QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

- Q #1: Approximately how many license plates will be available for artists to use in their project?
- A #1: We currently have about 700 license plates consisting of the series of the standard <u>'MYFLORIDA.COM</u>' plates & a variety of specialty plates. WE could easily provide double that amount if required by the artists.
- Q #2: If an Artists' design should stick out from (off) the wall, how many inches are available (i.e. 6" or 12") not to be an obstruction or safety issue in the interior exhibit area?
- A #2: We would allow up to six (6) inches from the wall. It may require a stand or shelf from the base of the artwork to the floor to prevent anything, such as chairs, from slipping underneath the artwork.
