- 5. Review BOCC assignments
 - a) June 11 BOCC Motion That we direct staff to prepare for the Board's consideration a policy position regarding the issuance of consumptive use permits in the Santa Fe Basin while the river is in a water management district declared recovery status. Refer to Environmental Protection Advisory Committee (EPAC) and let them know what we are doing and we want a policy in hand at the beginning of the next review process. (Stacie Greco)
 - Stacie explained that the county is in the process on hiring an expert to complete a technical peer review of available information. This work is scheduled to begin this fiscal year (before October).
 - b) Review Tree protection code standards (Steve Kabat, County Arborist)
 - Steve K. and Steve H. presented a current draft code and cover letter. The members requested that the last paragraph be removed from the cover letter and to add two additional recommendations. One, to present a tiered approach to the fee schedule based on tree size and two, add a provision that would allow open space credit and flexibility for additional heritage/specimen tree protection within the development project. Staff will bring these items back to their Sept. 3rd regular meeting.

- d) Rights of Nature update (Steve H.) staff is reviewing the policy and hopes to come back to the BOCC this fall.
