A Proclamation

Declaring November 11th, 2019 as “Colonel Charles D. Young Annual Veterans Breakfast Day” in Alachua County, Florida

- Whereas,** on November 11th of this year, we pay tribute to the service and sacrifice of the men and women who in defense of our freedom have bravely worn the uniform of the United States by celebrating Veterans Day; and
- Whereas,** Veterans of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, and Coast Guard have contributed exemplary service to American society in many ways; not just during their time on active duty; and
- Whereas,** the contributions of African-American veterans have been poorly presented in the history of our nation; and
- Whereas,** Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc, and various community and civic organizations, churches, and military and veteran agencies, will honor African American veterans during the Annual Colonel Charles D. Young Veterans Day Breakfast at the Martin Luther King, Jr. Multipurpose Center on November 11, 2019; and
- Whereas,** Colonel Young was the third African American to graduate from West Point Military Academy and earned his commission in 1889 and served in the 9th and 10th (Buffalo Soldiers) Cavalries; and Colonel Young was the first black commissioned officer to command a squadron of the 10th Cavalry; and
- Whereas,** “Veterans Hour 2019” will provide veterans an opportunity to share their military experience and total services to America at this Colonel Charles D. Young Veterans Day Breakfast.

Now, therefore, through the authority vested in me by the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, I do hereby proclaim November 11th, 2019 as “Colonel Charles D. Young Annual Veterans Breakfast Day” in Alachua County, Florida.
