Pursuant to F.S. 270.11, please consider this letter a request seeking the release of the County's statutory right to retain a three-fourths interest in the mineral rights and one-half interest in all petroleum rights on these parcels. The City requests this release due to the relatively small size of each property, and any mining activity would be impractical and would unreasonably interfere with or completely prohibit reasonable use of the property by the City. In addition, mineral rights encumbering the property would severely affect the City's ability to dispose of the properties and place them back on the property tax rolls.
