15 16	EFFECTIVE DATE. WHEREAS, the Charter of Alachua County grants the County Commission home rule
17	power to enact an Ordinance that does not conflict with State law; and
18	WHEREAS, Section 112.215(5), Fla. Stats., permits a county by ordinance to provide a
19	deferred compensation program to its employees; and
20	WHEREAS, Section 112.215(5), Fla. Stats., requires the ordinance designate a public
21	official body to make the determinations provided for by state law; and
22	WHEREAS, the County now desires to change the composition of the committee;
23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
24	COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
25	SECTION 1. Section 23.21 of the Alachua County Code, entitled "DEFERRED
26	COMPENSATION PROGRAM COMMITTEE; DEVELOPMENT OF PROGRAM," is hereby
27	amended to read:
28 29 30 31	Sec. 23.21. Deferred compensation program committee; development of program. (a) A deferred compensation program committee is established, which shall consist of the chairman of the board of county commissioners, the county manager, the county attorney, the human resources director, and the clerk of the circuit court, and the library director.

- SECTION 2. <u>Repealing Clause</u>. All ordinances or portions thereof in conflict herewith
 are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
- 3 **SECTION 3.** <u>Modification.</u> It is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that 4 the provisions of this ordinance may be modified as a result of considerations that may arise 5 during public hearings. Such modifications shall be incorporated into the final version of the 6 ordinance adopted by the Board and filed by the Clerk to the Board.
- SECTION 4. Severability. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision
 of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or
 unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the
 ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or
 application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
 SECTION 5. Inclusion in the Code. It is the intent of the Board of County
 Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, and it is hereby provided that the provisions of this

ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Alachua County,
Florida; that the section of this ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such
intent and that the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article", or other appropriate

SECTION 6. Effective Date. A certified copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the
 Department of State by the Clerk of the Board within ten days after enactment by the Board and
 shall take effect upon filing with the Department of State.
