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| 9 | WHEREAS, the Chair and Alachua County Commission recognize that in today's society, |
| 10 | some form of photographic identification is necessary to access many important services such as |
| 11 | banking, utilities enrolling in government programs and services, etc.; and |
| 12 | WHEREAS, it is often challenging for many residents in our community to obtain |
| 13 | government issued identification, including but not limited to, the elderly, formerly incarcerated |
| 14 | homeless persons, transgendered persons, persons from out of state; and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, numerous communities, both large and small, throughout the United |
| 16 | States of America, including but not limited to, Aiken, SC, Cincinnati, OH, Greensboro, NC, |
| 17 | Philadelphia, PA, Mercer County, NJ, Ames, Iowa, Charlottesville, Virginia, Hood River, |
| 18 | Oregon, and West Palm Beach, FL have adopted a FaithAction ID card, which conforms to |
| 19 | security standards, while being accessible to those who cannot acquire a government ID; |
| 20 | WHEREAS, the FaithAction ID card applicants must provide proof of identity, proof |
| 21 | of address, and proof of date of birth as required by F.S. 877.18, in order to confirm to strict |
| 22 | verification of identity; and |
| 23 | WHEREAS, Alachua County desires to encourage other government agencies, |
| 24 | business leadership, civic groups, community institutions and residents to join in a community- |
| 25 | wide effort to expand prosperity and inclusion for all residents. |
| 26 | NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY |

| 1 | COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS: |
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| 2 | SECTION 1. The Board finds the ability to obtain a community identification, as a |
| 3 | secondary form of identification, will be of assistance to homeless individuals, persons re- |
| 4 | entering the community after incarceration and those who do not have drivers' licenses, and is a |
| 5 | benefit to the general welfare of the County and community. |
| 6 | SECTION 2. The County hereby affirms that Alachua County will recognize and accept |
| 7 | the FaithAction ID cards issued as appropriate identification to access county services unless |
| 8 | another form of identification is required by Local, State or Federal Law. |
| 9 | SECTION 3. The County urges and encourages the business leadership, civic groups, |
| 10 | other government agencies, community institutions, and residents to recognize and participate in |
| 11 | the FaithAction ID program by recognizing the FaithAction ID card as valid identification, and by |
| 12 | obtaining and using a FaithAction ID card for themselves, as part of a community-wide effort to |
| 13 | expand prosperity and inclusion for all residents. |
| 14 | SECTION 4. The County Clerk is directed to provide a copy of this Resolution to all |
| 15 | county charter officers. |
| 16 | SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon approval by |
| 17 | the Board of County Commissioners. |
