Eligibility

The applicant must:

- Be a resident of Alachua County, Florida
- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be 18 years or older
- Not be a current high school or undergraduate student
- Not have been awarded a Major-Grant before

The Major-Grant cannot be used for:

- Travelling expenses
- Paying personal debts or expenses
- Commercial or for-profit activities nor for general or administrative expenses

Applications or work samples containing profanity, racism, sexism, homophobia, xenophobia, discriminatory behavior, or vulgarity will be disqualified.

Requirements:

- Projects must be completed within six months of award.
- The Alachua County Board of County Commissioners must be recognized on all printed documents (if applicable).
- Within 30 days of the close of the project, the applicant shall submit to the County a two paragraph report listing and describing the project expenditures and describing how the grant funding was used to complete the project.
- Copy of paid receipts and relevant backup documentation are required to receive reimbursements, not to exceed the maximum award amount.
