Declaring October 24th, 2020 as "United Nations Day" in Alachua County, Florida

Whereas,	the United Nations, with the adoption in 2015 of its 2030 Agenda, has pledged joint action across its organs and agencies, the donor communities and all countries so as to leave no one behind in delivering by 2030 on the 17 major Sustainable Development Goals that aim to end hunger and poverty, to achieve gender equality and quality education for all, to combat climate change and achieve environmental sustainability, and to actively address human suffering, by preventing conflict and alleviating the plight of refugees; and,
Whereas,	the United States, through the United Nations, has a long tradition of leading international efforts to improve health, education and economic growth in developing countries; and polls taken in the last five years show that 88% of US voters believe that it is important for the U.S. to maintain an active role at the UN; and
Whereas,	the United Nations Association of the USA, Gainesville Chapter, is committed to educating and mobilizing our local communities to create a more prosperous, just and sustainable world; and the Gainesville Chapter, has declared "Our ClimateOur Future" as its theme for the 2020 United Nations Day commemoration: and
