RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY Α COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE LEVY OF GENERAL COUNTY PURPOSE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2020 TAX YEAR; ADOPTING FINAL MILLAGE RATES; **ESTABLISHING** THE PERCENTAGE CHANGE FROM THE ROLLED BACK RATE; DIRECTING THE TRANSMITTAL OF CERTIFIED COPIES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, at the public hearing of September 8, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida adopted Resolution 20-80 approving the proposed millage rates and Resolution 20-81, approving a tentative general County budget; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with applicable law, the Board of County Commissioners advertised its proposed millage rates and its final County budget and advertised a public hearing date for adoption of the final millage rates and the final County budget for September 20, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, the September 22, 2020 public hearing has been held as specified in the advertisement and in accordance with applicable law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA;

1. That the following final millage rate to fund the final general County budget for fiscal year 2020-21 is hereby adopted in accordance with applicable law:

General Fund 7.8935 mills

2. The millage rate levied herein is lesser than the rolled back rate of 7.8961 by .0003 percent.

3. The County Manager is hereby authorized and directed to transmit certified copies of this resolution, as well as any other forms or documents required by state law, to the Alachua County Property Appraiser, the Alachua County Tax Collector, and to the State of Florida Department of Revenue.

4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
