

RESOLUTION 21-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE TO USE FOR MENTAL HEALTH AND/OR SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES FOR HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners for Alachua County, Florida entered into the Cooperative Agreement to Benefit Homeless Individuals (“CABHI”) grant application and awarded \$2,400,000 for a 3 year grant period beginning September 30, 2017 and ending September 29, 2020.

WHEREAS, an extension to this grant was awarded through April 30, 2021. It is necessary to receive unanticipated revenue to be used for mental health and/or substance abuse services for homeless individuals;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. That the fiscal year 2021 budget for the “CABHI Grant” is hereby established. By adoption of this Resolution, the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, hereby appropriates and permits the revenue and expenditure of the funds described above.
2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
