A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, DECLARING A DEFINATE TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER VACATING ABANDONING, DISCONTINUING AND CLOSING A PORTION OF NE 132nd TERRACE; AUTHORIZING STAFF TO ADVERTISE NOTICE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Alachua County Code Chapter 324.02(2), Alachua County Board of County Commissioners (County) received an application from property owners, James and Deborah Lofton, husband and wife and Gregory S. Moress to vacate a portion of NE 132nd Terrace in North Winsor as recorded in Deed Book "T", page 115 of the Public Records of Alachua County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") has the authority pursuant to Section 336.09, Florida Statute, and Section 324.01 of the Alachua County Code of Ordinances, to vacate, abandon, discontinue and close any existing public road, by resolution adopted at a duly noticed public hearing; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 336.10, Florida Statute, and Section 324.02 of the Alachua County Code of Ordinances, the Board must schedule a definite time and place for the public hearing, and authorize County staff to advertise notice of said public hearing, by resolution adopted at a public meeting of the Board.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to adopt a resolution declaring that, at a definite time and place, a public hearing will be held to consider the matter.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

The Board declares that at 5:00 p.m. on November 10, 2020, the Board will hold a public hearing to consider whether to vacate, abandon, discontinue and close that portion of the street described below, and generally depicted in **Exhibit A**, and to renounce and disclaim any right of the County and the public in and to any land in connection therewith:

The North 356.11 feet of NE 132nd Terrace Lying East of and adjacent to Lot 3 and lying West of and adjacent to Lot 5 of North Winsor as recorded in Deed Book T, Page 115 of the public records of Alachua County Florida.

- 2. At the public hearing, the Board shall hear all interested parties and shall determine whether it is in the best interest of the public welfare, and will not be injurious to the public welfare or violated individual property rights, to vacate, abandon, discontinue and close the Street.
- The Board authorizes and directs the County Manager, or her designee, to 3. advertise the notice of public hearing attached hereto as Exhibit "B" one time in a newspaper of general circulation within Alachua County, Florida, at least two weeks prior to the date of the public hearing.
