Authorize the Chair to sign the no cost change order to FDEP Grant Contract LP6102F for Habitat Restoration through Aeration and Revegetation at Hornsby Spring.

### Prior Board Motions

September 11, 2018 BoCC approved the budget amendment, resolution to recognize unanticipated revenue, an interfund loan and authorized the Chair to sign the agreement for the Habitat Restoration through Aeration and Revegetation at Hornsby Spring Grant LP6103F.

### Background:

The Environmental Protection Department has received funding from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection through Springs Grant Funding to conduct a habitat restoration project at Hornsby Spring in two phases. The first phase of the project will examine the role of dissolved oxygen levels on revegetation success, and particularly the relationship between grazing pressures applied by native snail species. The second phase of the project will include removal of nuisance algae and replanting of submerged aquatic vegetation within the spring pool.

This request for a no cost change order is needed to extend the timeframe for Task 2B, the final QAPP, from December 1, 2018 to February 1, 2019. This change reflects the actual delivery date of the final QAPP which, due to the complexity of the project, required more revisions than expected. This change does not affect the overall timeline of the project.
