The 3M 1860 model N95 mask would be the preferred choice as it is part of the 3M Healthcare series.

The 1860 model is fluid resistant and reduces exposure to harmful airborne particles < 100 micron eg. Bacillus anthracis, Mycrobacterium tuberculosis, mould, saus/Influenza virus.

The 8210/8200 models reduce exposure to H1N1 (swine flu) and H5N1 (bird flu) Influenza.

In the past, the state has supplied ACFR with the 8000, 8210 models in the past and I have recently purchased a small amount of the 8210 N95 mask for CSW stock.

The large PO is for DOH and the smaller one is for Fire Rescue (using COVID relief funds from State Department of Health).




