

## **RESOLUTION 20 -**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA ACCEPTING THE CLERK'S REPORT ON THE DISPOSAL OF ALACHUA COUNTY SURPLUS PROPERTY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Alachua County, a Charter County pursuant to Article VIII, Section 1(g), of the Florida Constitution, has all powers of local self-government not inconsistent with general law or with special law approved by vote of the electors; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 274.05, Florida Statutes, provides that a governmental unit may declare as surplus any of its property, which is not otherwise lawfully disposed of, that is obsolete or the continued use of which is uneconomical or inefficient, or which serves no useful function, and provides for a method of disposal of such property; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 274.06, Florida Statutes, provides an alternate procedure for disposing of surplus property; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 94-34 authorizes and delegated to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Alachua County, Florida (the "Clerk") the authority to declare as surplus such property owned by the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida (the "Board"), the Alachua County Clerk of Court, the Alachua County Property Appraiser, the Alachua County Tax Collector, and the Alachua County Supervisor of Elections, which property is obsolete or the continued use of which is uneconomical or inefficient or which serves no useful purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 94-34 also authorizes and delegates to the Clerk the authority to dispose of surplus property in accordance with either Section 274.05 or Section 274.06, *Florida Statutes*; and

**WHEREAS**, the Clerk declared the property listed on **Exhibit A** as surplus and subsequently disposed of same at an online auction for non-profit and other governmental units held through September 30, 2020 and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 94-34 requires the Clerk to provide a report to the Board on the disposal of all surplus property and to ensure that the disposal report is recorded in the minutes of the Board; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 274.07, Florida Statutes, requires that the authority for the disposal of surplus property shall be recorded in the Minutes of the Board.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

1. As authorized by Chapter 274, Florida Statutes, and Resolution 94-34, the Clerk has disposed of certain surplus property of the County described in the report attached hereto as Exhibit A - *Alachua County Vehicle Surplus Property Disposal Report* and incorporated herein.
2. The Clerk will adjust the property records of Alachua County to reflect the lawful disposition of the property on the *Alachua County Vehicle Surplus Property Disposal Report*.
3. By adoption of this resolution the Board accepts the Clerk's report on the disposal of the surplus property and directs the Clerk to record this resolution, including **Exhibit A**, in the minutes of the Board.
4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
