In my former hometown of Plantation, Florida(Broward County) my history is one of decades as an educator, a volunteer, and elective official. Even though I am new to the community "giving back to my community" is part of my DNA. So it is only natural for me to continue volunteering.

Brief Resume:

In considering me for the Tourist Development Council's position here is snapshot of my public service and volunteering background through the decades which will provide more insight on my qualifications for the position.

Serving as a Strong Mayor for the City of Plantation meant my position was not only an elective position, but also CEO/City Manager of the city. Under my direction there were fourteen directors with approximately 600 full time employers and 200 part time employees.
