

RESOLUTION 2021-_____

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO ITS BUDGET FOR THE 2020-21 FISCAL YEAR; AMENDING REVENUES, APPROPRIATIONS AND USE OF FUND BALANCE FOR THE MSTU - LAW ENFORCEMENT BUDGET; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the Alachua County Fiscal Year 2020-21 Final Budget; and,

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners amended the budget to adjust fund balance brought forward as it pertains to the MSTU - Law Enforcement budget pursuant to the procedures authorized by and required by Chapters 129 and 200, Florida Statutes;

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners amended the budget to adjust fund balance and amend the budget as it pertains to the MSTU - Law Enforcement budget pursuant to the procedures authorized by and required by Chapters 129 and 200, Florida Statutes;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust the fund balance brought forward and amend the budget as it pertains to the MSTU - Law Enforcement budget pursuant to the procedures authorized by and required by Chapters 129 and 200, Florida Statutes; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was advertised on August 8, 2021, as required by Chapters 129 and 200, Florida Statutes;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. That the fiscal year 2020-21 MSTU - Law Enforcement budget is hereby amended as reflected in the budget amendment attached hereto. By adoption of this resolution and the attached budget amendment, the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, hereby appropriates and permits the expenditure of the funds described therein.

2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
