Re: Springfield Subdivision – Water Line Extension

The Springfield Subdivision project is a 30-lot rural subdivision located off of NW 182nd Avenue in High Springs, Florida. The project proposes the construction of ±4,744 LF of 8" PVC water main, ±142 LF of 8" DIP water main, 7 fire hydrant assemblies, and associated fittings (valves, blow-offs, etc.) to serve the subdivision. In order to connect to High Springs' potable water, the line would need to be extended from the entrance of the neighboring Cinnamon Hills Subdivision and across an enclave parcel within unincorporated Alachua County.

We believe the project meets the criteria set forth in Alachua County's Comprehensive Plan Policy 3.1.5 as outlined below:

- a. The absence of this extension would deny the subdivision access to city-provided potable water, and thus result in a threat to public safety and health.
- b. The extension of such facilities would enhance the safety, and effectiveness of our potable water system. The site falls within the City of High Springs Urban Service Boundary, which is intended to be served by our utilities, per our Comprehensive Plan.
