## RESOLUTION 2021-107

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO ITS BUDGET FOR THE 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR; REVISING THE COUNTYBUDGET OFFICER'S ESTIMATE OF RECEIPTS AND OF BALANCES TO BE BROUGHT FORWARD; APPROVING A TENTATIVE MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNIT-LAW ENFORCEMENT BUDGET; SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING DATE; PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF NOTICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2021, the County Manager, as the Alachua County Budget Officer, presented a balanced budget for further consideration by the Board of County Commissioners in accordance with applicable law; and,

WHEREAS, said budget contained estimates of receipts and of balances brought forward

as part of the budget presentation; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to revise the Budget Officer's

estimates of receipts and of balances to be brought forward based on the most current information available as of the date of this resolution; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida, has complied with all conditions precedent to the adoption of a tentative Municipal Service Taxing Unit-Law Enforcement budget; and,

WHEREAS, the Board as of this date adopted a resolution approving proposed millage to fund the tentative Municipal Service Taxing Unit-Law Enforcement budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA.

1. In accordance with the requirements of Section 129.03, Florida Statutes, the Budget Officer's estimates of receipts and balances to be brought forward are revised as set out in the document entitled "FY22 Tentative Budget".

2. The tentative Municipal Service Taxing Unit-Law Enforcement budget contained in the document entitled "FY22 Tentative Budget" is hereby approved as adjusted by motion for further consideration at the public hearing established in this resolution.

3. A public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and final budget for the Municipal Service Taxing Unit-Law Enforcement on Tuesday the 28th of September, A.D., 2021 at 5:01 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Jack Durrance Auditorium, County Administration Building, Second Floor, 12 S.E. 1st Street, Gainesville, Florida.

4. The County Manager is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and publish all necessary and required notices prior to the hearing established herein, and to provide copies of this resolution to all parties as may be required by applicable law.

5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
