The Alachua County Department of Community Support Services will make available \$100,000,00 in SHIP SFY 2018-2019 (250) and 2019-2020 (251), for the Home Repair and Special Needs Programs. Program payments are made on a reimbursement basis.

Home Repair Program

Funding of \$100,000.00 is available to housing agencies with a preference to Veteran assistance housing. These funds are to be used for home repairs to very low and low-income households in Alachua County.

Twenty percent of funding must be used for Special needs as defined in 420.0004(13), F.S.

Applications for funding are available beginning April 1,2021 and are due by 1:00 p.m. on May 3, 2021 at 218 SE 24th St, Gainesville, FL, 32641. All funds must be expended by May 31, 2022.
