## RESOLUTION 2021-108

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE LEVY OF GENERAL COUNTY PURPOSE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2021 TAX YEAR; ADOPTING FINAL MILLAGE RATES; ESTABLISHING THE PERCENTAGE CHANGE FROM THE ROLLED BACK RATE; DIRECTING THE TRANSMITTAL OF CERTIFIED COPIES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, at the public hearing of September 14, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County, Florida adopted Resolution 2 0 2 1 - 1 0 4 approving the proposed millage rates and Resolution 2021-105, approving a tentative general County budget; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with applicable law, the Board of County Commissioners advertised its proposed millage rates and its final County budget and advertised a public hearing date for adoption of the final millage rates and the final County budget for September 28, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, the September 28, 2021 public hearing has been held as specified in the advertisement and in accordance with applicable law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA;

1. That the following final millage rate to fund the final general County budget for fiscal year 2021-22 is hereby adopted in accordance with applicable law:

General Fund

7.8622 mills

2. The millage rate levied herein is higher than the rolled back rate of 7.5923 by 3.61 percent.

3. The County Manager is hereby authorized and directed to transmit
certified copies of this resolution, as well as any other forms or documents required by
state law, to the Alachua County Property Appraiser, the Alachua County Tax Collector,
and to the State of Florida Department of Revenue.
4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
