Background:

On March 22, 2019, the County Manager entered into a Legal Representation Agreement with the firm of de la Parte & Gilbert regarding the proposed HPSII phosphate mine in Union/Bradford Counties.

On July 9, 2019 the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners approved the 1st Amendment to Legal Representation with the firm and approved a Budget Amendment to implement Task 1 and Task 2 only of the Agreement, for an amount not to exceed \$621,302.00.
