Background:

The Department of Community Support Services began accepting online CHOICES applications via ZoomGrants from interested agencies on June 12, 2019. The application period concluded on July

10, 2019. Thirteen applications were submitted with a total request for funds of \$1,021,660.00.

The County Manager appointed the five member CHOICES Grant Review Committee on July 1, 2019. The Committee convened on July 23, 2019. It conducted individual application reviews and scoring through August 5, 2019. On August 7, 2019 it met to reach a consensus and final funding allocations totaling \$465,000.00.
