On June 25, 2019 the Board of County Commissioners approved the Nature and Culture Destination Enhancement Grant application.

Fiscal Consideration:

Nature and Culture Destination Enhancement grants are funded by 85% of the third penny of Tourist Development Tax collections. The total award amount for the FY20 Grant is \$1,000,000.
