### **Background:**

The State of Florida Health Department is in immediate need to implement COVID-19 Preventative Measures at the Health Department Building, by cleaning all supply and return ducts, vents, and install GPS Ionization Systems in 6 rooftop chill water air handlers, and 5 rooftop AC units.

This emergency purchase is exempt from the County's competitive bidding requirements pursuant to Section 22.3-302(16) of the Alachua County Procurement Code.
